

IMMEDIATE PART-TIME JOB OPPORTUNITY: JUNIOR PUMPOUT BOAT CAPTAIN

The Arundel Rivers Federation is returning the popular pumpout boat once again this season to the South, West and Rhode Rivers. Junior pumpout boat captains will provide free pumpouts of vessels across our rivers each weekend through October. This is a great opportunity to be on the water this summer providing a critical service to our recreational boaters, and keeping our rivers clean!

Junior pumpout boat captains will operate a pumpout boat in the South, West and Rhode Rivers FOR up to two days each weekend between Thursday, May 26 and Sunday, October 30. Schedules will be flexible, allowing for multiple part-time pumpout boat operators to rotate through each weekend. Junior Pumpout Boat Captains will work up to two 8-hour shifts each weekend providing pumpout services to boaters from 9:00 am until 5:00 pm.

Responsibilities:

- Ensure the pumpout boat is generally available, weather permitting, for pumpouts to boaters across the South, West, and Rhode Rivers on a rotational basis from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on the days agreed to by you and the Senior Pumpout Boat Captain.
- Furnish all data necessary for grant compliance as requested by Arundel Rivers.
- Operate the pumpout boat in a safe manner at all times, and ensure that all occupants onboard follow Maryland State boating safety requirements.
- Store the pumpout boat safely each evening, and report maintenance issues to the Senior Pumpout Boat Captain.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Boat handling experience is required
- Knowledgeable of basic boat maintenance
- Knowledgeable and proficient in handling a small vessel in close quarters in a safe manner
- Basic knowledge of the navigable waters of the South, West and Rhode Rivers
- Able to lift 50 pounds
- Able to work flexibly and cooperatively with a team
- Able to adapt to changing weather conditions
